Recommendation for Fee Acceptance for Consultant Services for
Feasibility Study at Windsor Mills Middle School Site
March 12, 2002

On January 14, 2002, the Board of Education granted approval for the Department of Physical Facilities to enter into negotiations with the firm of Grimm & Parker Architects to conduct a Feasibility Study at the Windsor Mills Middle School Site. This study will include, but not be limited to, a preliminary site analysis for stormwater management, wetlands determination, forest buffer delineation, and utilities analysis, as well as development of several middle school concept plans. The Department of Physical Facilities has negotiated a fee of \$54,000.00 to complete the Feasibility Study.

At this time, the Department of Physical Facilities recommends acceptance of the negotiated fee in the amount of \$54,000.00 with Grimm & Parker Architects to conduct the Feasibility Study at the Windsor Mills Middle School Site. Funding for these services is available in Capital Budget Project #091 - Windsor Mills Middle School.
