Towson, MD – While in-person seating will be limited at upcoming Baltimore County Public Schools' high school graduations, friends, extended family, and community members are invited to witness these milestone events via livestream.

More than 7,000 students will graduate from BCPS this spring. All graduations will be held at Towson University's SECU Arena, unless otherwise noted.
