Community College of Baltimore County FAMILY LITERACY ENGLISH FOR SPEAKERS OF OTHER LANGUAGES (ESOL)

The Family Literacy ESOL Program for non-native English speaking parents is designed to help parents learn English language skills for life, work, and to help with their child's education.

The student must have a child 0–16 years old living in the home and enrolled in a Baltimore County Public School or the Judy Center of Baltimore County.

*No Class Cost – Grant funded program. Student textbook and workbook are not included.

In-Person and Zoom classes are available.

Due to COVID-19, placement testing and registrations are following the safety guidelines from the state, county and partner locations.

How to register:

- To register for any Family Literacy ESOL class, go to any of the locations listed.
- Registrations are **in person only**. No phone or mail-in registration.
- Arrive on time. Registration is on a first-come, first-served basis and will take 2 to 3 hours.
- Students must be at least 18 years of age and officially withdrawn from high school to enroll.
- To request an accommodation for a disability, please call 443-840-3428. Please allow staff adequate time to arrange before registration.
- Students with an F-1 or J-1 visa are not eligible for these grant funded* classes.
- All students **MUST** take a test.
- For safety, space in the room is limited. You need to practice social distancing while waiting to register.
- Due to Covid-19, masks may be required at registration.
- Only registering students are allowed inside the registration room. No family members or friends are allowed in the registration room.

Only Registering Students Allowed Inside.

Morning or evening classes are offered and held two or three times per week for a total of 60 hours. Classes begin in March and end in June.

All students will need a smart phone.

For online Zoom Classes, students must have a computer, with a camera and microphone, and unlimited internet access and a smart phone.

To register, all students must come to one of the Walk-in Family Literacy ESOL Placement and Registration Locations.
