<p>Action Step(s):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Implement daily lesson plans aligned to course level standards that focus on “Rule of 4” and Next Generation Science Standards (<i>The “Rule of Four” is a teaching method designed to increase the understanding of math and science through multiple representations of problems and concepts.</i>) • Implement math drills that focus on building SAT skills such as time management and breaking down the problems

<p>Action Step(s):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Increase the level of academic rigor in Standard and Honors level courses by implementing lessons aligned to course level standards with an emphasis on annotation and claim and evidence (reading) • Design content-based assessments that require development of claim, reasoning, and evidence (writing) • Implement drills and practice assessments to increase individual performance on the Evidence-Based Reading and Writing section of the SAT

- Implement a 9th Grade Team that aids in the transition of students and families to high school
- Implement a 10th grade mentoring program that supports the SEL and academic needs of identified students
