

## AP Registration Directions, Reminders, Testing Dates

All Woodlawn Students taking AP classes must take the AP exam for all of their AP classes! It is a requirement of the AP class.

### Registration

- Students will need to [create a College Board account](#) in order to register for their AP exams and will need to use the [AP Join Code](#) that their teacher(s) will provide to them to join the appropriate class sections.
  - This not only will register students for the exam but will give them access to AP Classroom resources that will be used in class and will in turn prepare them for the AP exams.
- When creating their College Board accounts it is **extremely important** that students:
  - use their full legal name (no nicknames or abbreviations)
  - use a personal email address **NOT** their BCPS credentials
  - Students who do not follow the above directions will need to call College Board to correct their names, to reset their email address choice, or to reset their password if they are having difficulty.
    - AP teachers and the school's AP Coordinator **CANNOT** help students with the above.
    - Do **NOT** create another account if you cannot access your previous account. Call College Board!
- Students need to create their accounts and join their class sections by **Friday, November 4th at 2:15 PM.**
  - It is important to register early so you can understand what exams you are taking and when they take place.

### Paying for Exams

- Students who qualify for Free and Reduced Meals and/or qualify for and sign the Universal Fee Waiver form (Found in the [FOCUS parent portal](#)) will have their exam covered by Baltimore County Public Schools.
  - To fill out the digital version of the Universal Fee Waiver through FOCUS use the directions [here](#). If your parent/guardian does not have a FOCUS account [here are the directions](#).
    - Students that do NOT qualify for the above will need to pay \$97 per exam (AP Seminar is \$145)
    - **If you are only taking 1 exam BCPS will pay for it.**
    - If a student no-shows for their exam they will be charged \$40.
      - This will follow you until graduation as an obligation.
  - There is an online portal to pay for exams. Information for this will be forthcoming.
  - Students that have extenuating circumstances and miss their AP exam will need to provide documentation and will need to contact the AP Coordinator (Mrs. O'Brocki-Kreft: Room M236, [sobrocki2@bcps.org](mailto:sobrocki2@bcps.org)) ASAP to reschedule!
    - If this does not happen in a timely manner or at all, students will need to pay the \$40 no show fee.
    - If students have a religious observance the day of an exam please speak with Mrs.O'Brocki-Kreft **IN ADVANCE** to reschedule your exam.
