Calendar/Grade Reporting Updates

- Final exam administration concludes for most students on today, June 9th.
- **June 10th – June 16th are dates reserved for make-up exams only. Students should only attend, as needed, if they have missed a final exam.**
- **Students who have completed all final exams by June 9th will not have attendance or grades negatively impacted for not attending school June 10th – June 16th.**
- June 15 and June 16th are half days for all students who attend. School will dismiss at 11:15 AM.
- 4th Quarter Report Cards will be distributed via USPS mail and made available online on June 16th at 5pm.
- Archived Report cards can be viewed at any time through the Focus web portal. To access report cards electronically- just ask your student for their bcps username & password to log in to <https://baltimore.focusschoolsoftware.com/focus/> click “reports” and then select the current report card to view.
