BAISD Return to Learn Planning

Purpose

As the Governor released the **Michigan's Return to School Roadmap** on June 30, 2020, our team of educators came together across districts from both Bay and Arenac counties to begin the process of creating a unified BAISD plan. The Purpose of the BAISD Return to Learn Work Group is to develop a cohesive plan for school districts in Bay and Arenac Counties to return to school for the 2020-2021 school year in the safest way possible.

Process

The members of the BAISD Return to Learn Work Group are also members of their district/building level teams which include a wide representation of stakeholders in education including teachers, food service staff, technology staff, custodial staff, parents, students, and others. Our members bring the input from their district/building level teams to this BAISD Work Group to collaborate around creating the most safe and effective plan based on the guidance from **Michigan's 2020-21 Return to School Roadmap**. Our plan will include Safety Protocols, Instructional Expectations, Support for Mental and Social Emotional Health, and Operational Procedures.

Timeline

Three plans are being developed will be released in late July or early August

The plans are dependent on what phase our state is in for the **MI Safe Start Plan**.

- 1) Schools open for in-person instruction with moderate required safety protocols (MI Safe Start Phase 5).
- 2) Schools open for in-person instruction with more stringent required safety protocols (MI Safe Start Phase 4).
- 3) Schools do not open for in-person instruction and instruction is provided remotely (MI Safe Start Phases 1-3)
